Annex 3

Manufacture of Synthetic Fibres

For the purposes of the Programme, the manufacture of synthetic fibres is understood as:

- a) extrusion or texturisation of all types of sheared fibres and yarn fibres based on polyester, polyamide, acrylate or polypropylene, regardless of the end-use of the products produced from them, or
- b) polymerisation, including polycondensation, if it is a component of extrusion, or
- c) each accompanying process related to the introduction of extrusion or texturing technology by the Applicant or other business entity belonging to the concern and which in the given commercial activity is a common part of the process of extruding or texturing fibres.
