- D The applicant's experience and qualifications
- E Preparedness of the applicant
- F Technical solution of the project and sustainability thereof

Each part is further subdivided.

If a project submitted by an aid applicant receives at least one negative evaluation in part A, the project will be excluded from further evaluation as unacceptable.

Parts B and F are based on a points system – the awarded number of points can be in the stated points range according to the assessment carried out by an external evaluator (EE) or project manager (PM). Each part contains space for commentary on the points evaluation, which is an inseparable part of the project assessment performed by the EE or PM. Space for commentary can be expanded if necessary.

The sum of points from parts B through F is the total points evaluation of the project. The project can receive a maximum of 100 points.





The minimum number of points needed for fulfilment of the programme's criteria and approval of the project is **50** points

Non-fulfilment of the programme's criteria constitutes a reason for rejection of the aid application.

A high-tech repair centre performs repairs of any of the following items:

office machines; computer technology; electronic machines and instruments; electronic devices and instruments (radio, television, communication); optical, measuring and precision instruments; electronic and control systems of rail vehicles; repairs of vehicles in the express-train category; electronic weapons systems; machines and systems in the area of space technology; airplanes and air-transport vehicles; scientific instruments; medical instruments (electro-diagnostic instruments, drills, etc.); equipment for managing industrial processes; telecommunications devices and systems; navigation devices; CNC machines; components of nuclear power plants.

Repair of automobiles and other vehicles intended for ground transport is not considered a high-tech activity.
