The following activities shall no longer be supported: manufacture, processing, and marketing of products listed Annex 1 of this Call, the steel industry defined in Annex 2 of this Call, and manufacture of synthetic fibres defined in Annex 3 of this Call.

The above-mentioned restrictions concern the subject of project implementation, not the subject of the enterprise's activities.

For the activity “**Creation of new IS/ICT solutions and applications**”, the subject of project implementation will be, in particular, Section 72 – Computer and related activities, as the case may be, other related sections. In the project description and in the business plan, the Applicant shall also state the anticipated outputs of the project and the sector in which they will be utilised.

Within the framework of support for **business support services** (shared services centres, customer support centres, and centres for the repair of high-tech products and technologies), the subject of project implementation shall be:

- a) an activity for the performance of which the centre was founded and for which it is authorised to conduct business (audit, processing and administration of accounting, repairs of products and technologies, etc.) – in the case that this concerns an independent legal entity.
- b) if the centre is part of the Applicant's internal organisational structure, the subject of project implementation shall consist in those activities of the Applicant on which the establishment or development of the centre will have the greatest impact; if these activities cannot be precisely specified, it applies that the project will be implemented by the Applicant as a whole (the project's impact shall be focused on all area's of the Applicant's business).

In the case that the project is focused on establishing or developing a shared services centre, the Applicant shall also state in the Registration Application the subject of the centre's activity by selecting from the following:

- accounting

- finance, audit
- administration in the area of human resources
- information systems administration
- graphics, animation, design
- marketing
- data processing
- other

It is possible to choose more than one activity. If the Applicant selects the “other” item, it shall provide a detailed specification of the subject of activity in the project description.
