### South Bohemia region

Robert Bosch, a German manufacturer of automotive components, is expanding its research and testing centre and manufacturing plant in České Budějovice. This high-tech investment in the value of CZK 2.2 billion will bring to the region 625 new jobs for both labourers and university-educated professionals.

### Yanfeng Czechia Automotive Interior Systems s.r.o.

South Bohemia region

By the beginning of 2018, this global supplier of automobile interior solutions will commence new operations involving production of instrument panels and door panels in Planá nad Lužnicí. The company anticipates that it will create 500 new jobs and invest CZK 1.45 billion by 2012. The new manufacturing plant is planned as a showcase for the global Industry 4.0 strategy within the company. Two hundred of the 500 new positions will be intended for highly qualified workers.

### GE Aviation Czech s.r.o.

#### Central Bohemia region

The American company GE Aviation plans to develop, test and manufacture turboprop engines in the Czech Republic. This investment with high value added will place the Czech Republic among the global elite of aerospace manufacturers and will create 500 high-skilled jobs.

### Deutsche Telekom Services Europe Czech Republic s.r.o.

### South Moravia region

Deutsche Telekom, the largest German provider of telecommunication services, opened a shared-services centre in Brno. The centre serves European customers, particularly in the area of finance and accounting. The investment in the value of CZK 500 million should create 565 new jobs within three years, especially for workers with good language skills.

This Dutch company focused on designing the Europe-wide internet established its new centre in Prague, where it plans to employ up to 125 highly qualified engineers in the area of telecommunications.

### Spielberk Office Centre Brno

South Moravia region

The Spielberk Office Centre complex is located in an attractive area of Brno. The centre is easily accessible from the D1 and D2 motorways and offers more than 80,000 m<sup>2</sup> of high-quality office spaces in five separate five-storey buildings. A major investor that pledged to create up to 500 jobs occupied premises in the centre in 2016.

### Siemens, s.r.o.

With nearly ten thousand employees, Siemens ranks among the most significant employees in the Czech Republic. The company's development and design centre, which currently employs nearly 300 highly qualified specialists, focuses on development activities in the areas of industrial automation, smart infrastructure and public transport. Siemens employs 600 people in research and development in the Czech Republic.
