





Industrial zones

- -- **Lesna** the site is divided into two parts: 37 ha and 15 ha. Owned by the City of Valasske Mezirici
- Toma Otrokovice 11 ha available, very good infrastructure, close to planned expressway
- Chropyne 3.5 ha available, also very good infrastructure, very good connection to expressway
- -- **Holesov** 280 ha currently under development, readiness planned for 2008-09









Industrial zones

- Zlin-East 23 ha zone in the suburban area
 of the City of Zlin, almost fully occupied
- -- Vsetín Bobrky 24 ha zone near Vsetin, currently fully occupied

 Nivnice-Kluka – 10.5 ha available, still awaiting significant investor, under municipal ownership

- -- **Svit zone** 70 ha, large number of buildings in bad condition, unresolved ownership, located in the centre of Zlin
- -- Slavicin Zone 300 ha in size, unusual shape, buildings are in bad condition, already several companies on site
- -- **Bojkovice farm** 7.6 ha, under majority ownership of the state
- -- **Army base Divnice** 7.5 ha, under municipal ownership
- Hostice Farm 3.8 ha, land under municipal ownership, buildings under private ownership





Activities Supporting SMEs and CZECHINVEST Regional Development

- -- **JROP** Operational Programme supporting SMEs in economically distressed areas in the Zlin Region (2004-2006)
- ROP Operational programme supporting
 SME'S prepared for NUTS II-3 main blocks:
 Transportation, Regional regeneration, Tourism
- -- OPPI Operational Programme Enterprise and Innovation – under the Ministry of Industry and Trade: 15 programmes proposed, mostly in the manufacturing industry










Reasons to invest in the Zlin region
